History Department- 2019-2020

In the academic year 2019-20, History Department of Elphinstone college hosted various events promoting History and Heritage Studies. Visits to locations with high significance to Heritage of India, Workshops, Quiz, Essay Competitions, Postermaking and such were organized by the department on multiple occasions. Ranade society of History students, remained active throughout the year focusing on creating awareness through social programs, Chart making, displaying documentaries, and short stories related to History & General Affairs. A huge response was received from the student body participating in these events. To name a few:

- Mani Bhavan Visit: A visit to Mani Bhavan was organized on the occasion of 150th Birth Anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi.
- Quiz and Elocution Competition on 150th Birth Anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi.
- National Museum of Indian Cinema: A visit to National Museum of Indian Cinema was organized for the T.Y. students of the department with History as their Major.
- **Poster-making** on various important Heritage Sites in India.
- Know Your Coins Workshop: : The workshop titled "Know Your Coins – Know Your History" was conducted by Indian Numismatics, Historical and Cultural Research Foundation (INHCRF), in collaboration with Hinduja Foundation. Dr. Amiteshwar Jha (Director of INHCRF) guided students through the extensive subject of Numismatics . It has been a great learning experience for the students as it was hand-on experience dealing with ancient coins.

The lecture was conducted by Dr. Prachi Moghe, Assistant Professor at CEMS. A very detailed presentation on Cultural and Natural Heritage of Maharashtra was delivered by Dr. Prachi Moghe which was followed by a thorough Q&A with the students as well as the attending faculty. It was immensely beneficial for the students as the topics covered were a part of their syllabus.
